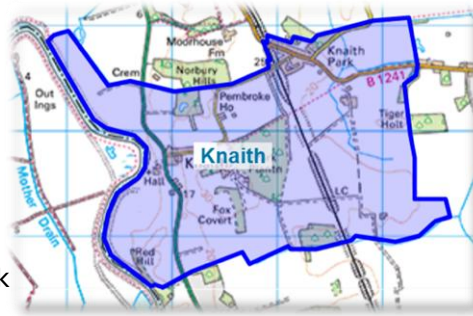

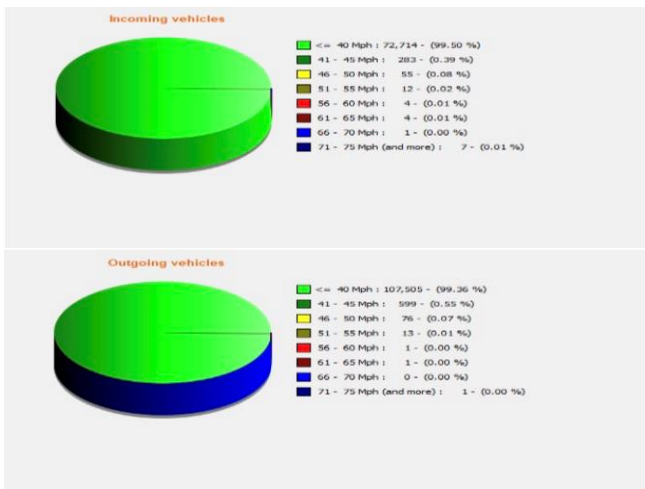

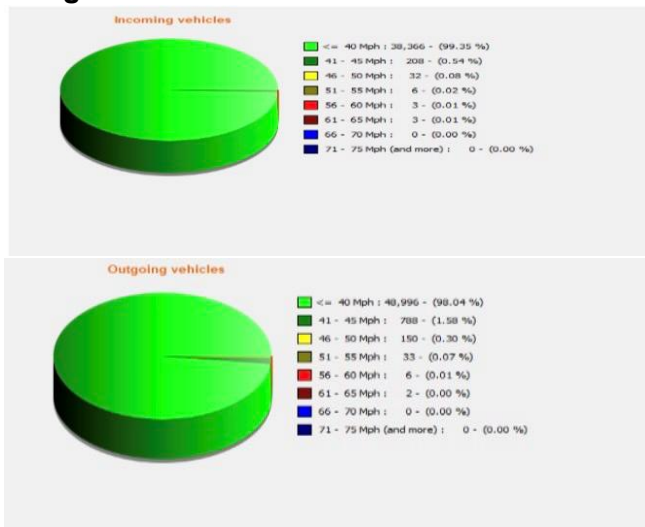
### Speed Data
